1 A BILL to amend and reenact §5-1-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to the designation of daylight saving time.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §5-1-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. THE GOVERNOR.

§5-1-25. Designation of daylight saving time as official time.

1 Daylight saving time shall be the statewide official time, commencing at two o'clock
2 antemeridian on the ~~last~~ second Sunday of ~~April~~ March and terminating at two o'clock
3 antemeridian on the ~~last~~ first Sunday of ~~October~~ November; ~~said~~ this time shall apply to all public
4 schools, institutions of higher learning, agencies, departments and political subdivisions of the
5 state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to bring the state code relating to daylight saving time in conformity with federal code and practice.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
