1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
 3 to licensing procedures for osteopathic physicians.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2018, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-14-14 of this code, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (licensing  
 3 procedures for osteopathic physicians, [24 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensing procedures for osteopathic physicians.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
