1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 recordkeeping and automated data processing systems.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2019, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the
 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 10, 2019,
 4 relating to the Board of Pharmacy (record keeping and automated data processing systems, [15](#)
 5 [CSR 04](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to record keeping and automated data processing systems.
