1 AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of federal funds out of the State Treasury from  
2 the balance of federal moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June  
3 30, 2020, to the Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Human  
4 Services, fund 8722, fiscal year 2020, organization 0511, by supplementing and amending  
5 the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

6 Whereas, The Governor has established the availability of federal funds for expenditure  
7 in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, which is hereby appropriated by the terms of this  
8 supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to fund 8722, fiscal  
2 year 2020, organization 0511, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of  
3 appropriation as follows:
