Pursuant to the call of the Chairman, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on January 10, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. in Room 208-W.

S. B. 177 - Fire Commission rule relating to State Building Code.

S. B. 190 - DOH rule relating to employment procedures.


Debra Graham, Counsel, explained the bill and responded to questions.


