1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Conservation Agency to promulgate a legislative rule relating to operation
 3 of West Virginia State Conservation Committee and conservation districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS
 AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Conservation Agency.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 12, 2022, authorized under the
 2 authority of §19-21A-4a of this code, modified by the Conservation Agency to meet the objections
 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September
 4 20, 2022, relating to the Conservation Agency (operation of West Virginia State Conservation
 5 Committee and conservation districts, [63 CSR 01](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Conservation Agency to promulgate a legislative rule relating to operation of West Virginia State Conservation Committee and conservation districts.
