1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to inspections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS
AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 4, 2022, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the
3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 17, 2022,
4 relating to the Board of Pharmacy (inspections, [15 CSR 19](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to inspections.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
